

Northwest Science Editor Wanted

The Northwest Scientific Association (NWSA) seeks a new Chief Editor of *Northwest Science* — the Pacific Northwest's only regional journal that ranges across the natural sciences.

NWSA has published *Northwest Science* continuously since 1927. In addition to original, peer-reviewed research articles, *Northwest Science* contains research notes, commentaries, special topic collections, and book reviews. Paper lengths, including references and figure captions, rarely exceed 10,000 words for research articles and 3,500 words for notes. New issues appear quarterly. Full journal content since 2007 is available online (<https://bioone.org/journals/northwest-science>) and is free for NWSA members.



Responsibilities

- Oversee workflow involved with publishing approximately six scientific papers per issue (four issues per year), aided by electronic submittal management software
- Increase and diversify submissions to the journal
- Recruit Associate Editors as needed
- Provide a written annual report describing journal status
- Serve on the NWSA Board of Directors
- Serve for a three-year, renewable term

Qualifications

- An established record of scientific publications
- A breadth of scientific knowledge
- Good communication skills
- Availability to commit roughly 20 hours per month to the journal
- Appreciation for the value of a regional scientific journal

The Chief Editor receives complimentary NWSA membership and annual meeting registration, as well as recognition for scientific service.
